

ORDINANCE NO. 583-16

AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING THE WAHKIAKUM COUNTY SOLID WASTE ORDINANCE INTO THE TOWN OF CATHLAMET MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, the Town of Cathlamet seeks to promote the general health, safety, and welfare of its residents and the general public through Ordinances regulating problem situations such as abandoned vehicles, vegetation, fire and other hazards; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Cathlamet is the County Seat of Wahkiakum County; and

WHEREAS, Wahkiakum County has adopted a comprehensive Solid Waste Nuisance Ordinance No. 161-16 within said County; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Cathlamet desires to ensure that County Ordinance No. 161-16 can be lawfully enforced within the Town limits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CATHLAMET AS FOLLOWS:

CMC Title 8 – HEALTH AND SAFETY, Chapter 8.35 is hereby added to the Cathlamet Municipal Code, as follows:

Chapter 8.35 Solid Waste

8.35.010 Adoption of Wahkiakum County Solid Waste Nuisance Ordinance.

Wahkiakum County Ordinance No. 161-16, Establishing a Solid Waste Nuisance Ordinance Within the County of Wahkiakum, as adopted on January 19, 2016, and amended in the future, is hereby incorporated into this Chapter in its entirety as though fully set forth herein. Enforcement, investigations, appeals and other provisions of Ordinance No. 161-16 shall be pursued within Town limits so long as executed by Wahkiakum County without cost or charge to the Town.

8.35.020 More Restrictive Town Ordinances to Govern.

If any provision of Wahkiakum County Ordinance No. 161-16 is found to conflict with any provision of Chapter 8.20, 10.15, or any other provision in the Cathlamet Municipal Code, such other provisions of the Municipal Code shall govern.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after passage and publication as required by law.
